

At their regular meeting on January 26, 2010, the Board of Directors of Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District called director elections within and for the following precincts: Precinct 2, the southeastern portion of Carson County and the northeast corner of Armstrong County; Precinct 4, the southern portion of Gray County and the northern portion of Donley County and the southwestern portion of Wheeler County; Precinct 6, the remainder of Armstrong County; Precinct 8, the major eastern portion of Wheeler County. One director will be elected to a four-year term for each individual precinct.

Current directors of these precincts are: Precinct 2 – Billy Van Crawford; Precinct 4 – Charles Bowers; Precinct 6 – Jim Thompson; Precinct 8 – Danny Hardcastle.

The Board of Directors is responsible for legal, financial and business matters of the District. To qualify to serve as a director, an individual must be a registered voter in that precinct. Applications are available at the District office, 201 W Third Street, White Deer, Texas. All applications must be signed by the applicant, notarized and filed in accordance with the election code.
