

LEGAL NOTICE

The Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District (District), in compliance with Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code and its Rules, will receive public comment on proposed amendments to the Rules of the District at a public hearing to be held at the District Office, 201 West Third Street, White Deer, Texas 79097 at 9:00 a.m. on December 20, 2018. The proposed amendments relate primarily to deleting the District's prior depletion rules and requiring all non-exempt wells in the District to obtain an operating permit based on the previously-adopted 1-acre-foot/acre/year Maximum Allowable Volume for a Contiguous Acre Tract. The proposed amendments also require all wells producing more than 35 gallons per minute to be metered, as well as reorganize and streamline the District's current rules.

The District Board, at the conclusion of the public hearing, will discuss comments received and consider possible adoption of the rule amendments. Written and oral public comments on the proposed rules must be submitted to the District on or prior to the hearing date.
