

**Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District's  
Notice of Public Comment Period on Adoption of Proposed  
Desired Future Conditions**

The Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District ("District") is currently receiving public comments on the 90-day period beginning May 13, 2016 and ending August 15, 2016, on the proposed desired future conditions (hereinafter "DFCs") for the area aquifers that were recently adopted by the Groundwater Management Area 1 under §36.108, Texas Water Code. Groundwater Management Area 1 includes the groundwater conservation districts as follows: Hemphill County Underground Water Conservation District, High Plains Underground Water Conservation District No. 1, North Plains Groundwater Conservation District and Panhandle Groundwater Conservation District. The proposed DFCs for the District are:

1. Ogallala Aquifer DFC:
  - A. At least 50% of the volume in storage remaining in 50 Years for the period 2012-2062.
  
2. Dockum Aquifer DFC:
  - A. No more than 30 feet of average decline in water levels for the period of 50 years 2012-2062.

The District will also conduct a public hearing concerning the District's intent to adopt proposed DFCs on July 14, 2016 at 1:30 P.M. at the District office at 201 W. Third St., White Deer, Texas. The public hearing notice and agenda will be posted at a later date.

A ninety (90) day public comment period has been established beginning May 13, 2016 and ending August 15, 2016.
